Michael met his wife, Mary, at Northwestern University School of Music. They recently celebrated their fiftieth anniversary. Mary is a retired reading specialist with a lovely voice. They have two children, both married and doing well, and three wonderful California grandchildren.

A graduate of Smith College and Teachers College, Columbia University, Ruth Friendly's first career was as a faculty member in the Scarsdale School System, where she taught and worked on curriculum development for over fifteen years. Widowed at an early age, she subsequently met and married Fred Friendly, and they merged their two families — six kids under one roof.

Ruth began her second career in 1982, working at Media and Society Seminars, founded by her husband Fred. Starting as a researcher, she moved on to become an editor, producer, and executive producer on more than 100 hours of programming airing nationally on PBS, including The Constitution, That Delicate Balance, Managing Our Miracles, Health Care in America, Ethics in America, and That Delicate Balance II: Our Bill of Rights. After her husband's death in 1998, Ruth took over as Director of Media and Society Seminars and became Vice President and Senior Editorial Director of Fred Friendly Seminars (FFS). This successor organization took over the production responsibilities. The FFS programs produced for PBS include Minds on the Edge, Ethics in America 2, Our Genes/ Our Choices, Who Cares, Chronic Illness in America, Epidemic, and Beyond Black and White.' Affirmative Action in America. Over the years, Ruth has also produced more than 300 non-televised seminars for medical, legal, educational, governmental, and civic groups across the country.

In the 2000s, Ruth served eight years as a Commissioner on the New York State Commission of Nomination, Court of Appeals. She also served as a panel member for the Disciplinary Committee of the Appellate Division, New York Supreme Court. She is an active board member of the RSS-Center for Ageless Living (RSS) and Riverdale Neighborhood House (RNH).

Ruth delights in sharing her free time with her six children and their families, including ten amazing grandchildren and five prized great-grandchildren.

Robert (Bob) Rubinstein was born and raised in the Bronx, attending P.S. 86 and the Bronx High School of Science, where he met his wife, Barbara. After graduating from Bates College on the Dean's list and captain of the Debate team, he served two years as a cryptographic specialist in Korea and subsequently attended NYU Law School.

Bob and his family moved to Riverdale in 1959 at the

urging of his father, Max, who was then the first principal of Jr. High School 141. Bob and Barbara's children, Lisa, Kenneth, and Adam, attended the local public schools, and Bob immediately immersed himself in Riverdale life. As a founder of the Ben Franklin Reform Democratic Club, he ran for Assembly in the first Democratic primary ever held in the Bronx, with the endorsements of Eleanor Roosevelt and Governor Herbert Lehman.

Bob served as the first President of Riverdale Senior Services (RSS) for five years. He is an active board member, serving on several committees, including chairman of the Personnel Committee. Bob was instrumental in securing funds for RSS's Rev. William Tieck Adult Day Program for Memory Loss. In addition, he is a former Vice President and Board Member of Riverdale Neighborhood House (RNH) and an active member of the Kiwanis Club of Riverdale for 60 years, serving in various leadership roles. He served as the Lieutenant Governor for the Bronx-Westchester division and is the club's Vice President. As President of the Riverdale Community Council, he was honored as "Riverdalian of the Year" in 1969. He has actively supported Mosaic (formerly Riverdale Mental Health) and even managed a South Riverdale Little League team.

Over the years, Bob has been a strong community activist. He has acted as a pro-bono attorney for minorities unfairly discriminated against by Riverdale landlords by organizing community protests whose efforts resulted in the integration of Skyview and other buildings in Riverdale; he almost single-handedly led the fight to save Seton Park for public use; he worked with planners and the community to designate a large portion of Riverdale as a Greenbelt area, he served under Mayor Lindsay as General Counsel of the Housing Development Administration, and managed to operate a successful Law Practice specializing in Real Estate Law in Riverdale for 60 years. In his law practice, Bob has represented local businesses against landlord's abusive rent hikes and was successful in reversed "pet discrimination" at The Windsor's Apartments. While Bob is semi-retired, he continues practicing law from the comfort of his Riverdale home!
