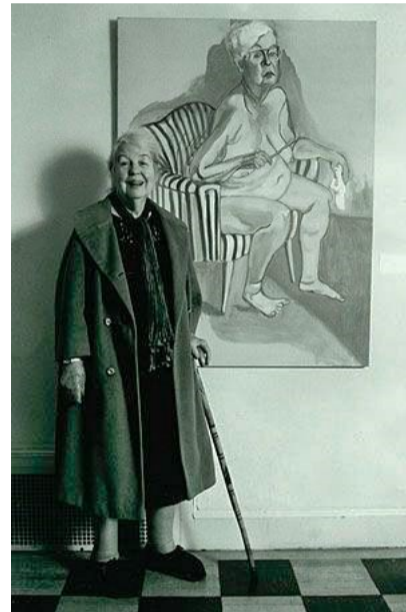
WOMEN'S CIRCLE

Alice Neel 1900 - 1984 one of the most important American portrait painters of the twentieth century.

New Yorkers Faith Ringgold and Alice Neel exemplify ageless living through their art practices. Both artists are also included in an exhibit at Gracie Mansion that Chirlane McCray organized to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the 19th amendment granting women the right to vote. November 21st and will be led by Dr. Susan Landgraf.

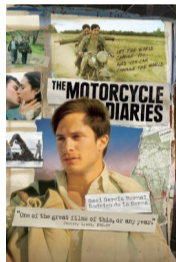
OCTOBER MOVIES-INTERNATIONAL MONTH

October 9-Motorcycle Diaries



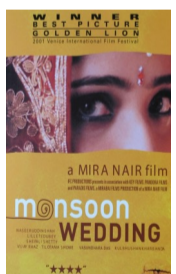
On a break before his last semester of medical school, Ernesto "Che" Guevara (Gael García Bernal) travels with his friend Alberto Granado (Rodrigo De la Serna) from Brazil to Peru by motorcycle. The two men soon witness the great disparities in South America, encountering poor peasants and observing the exploitation of labor by wealthy industrialists. When they reach a leper colony in Peru, Ernesto's values have changed so much that he sides with the sufferers, forgetting his own comfort.

October 16-Crouching Tiger Hidden Dragons



In 19th century Qing Dynasty China, a warrior (Chow Yun-Fat) gives his sword, Green Destiny, to his lover (Michelle Yeoh) to deliver to safe keeping, but it is stolen, and the chase is on to find it. The search leads to the House of Yu where the story takes on a whole different level.

Oct 23- Monsoon Wedding



A BAFTA-winning film about a father, Lalit Verma, trying to marry off his daughter, Aditi, in the traditional manner. Aditi is having second thoughts, while her cousin Ayesha Verma, 17, is just beginning to realise she's attractive to boys, and her other cousin, Ria, has a shocking revelation ready. Her brother, however, just wants to dance.

OCTOBER 30(Hotel Rwanda)



Paul Rusesabagina (Don Cheadle), a Hutu, manages the Hôtel des Mille Collines and lives a happy life with his Tutsi wife (Sophie Okonedo) and their three children. But when Hutu military forces initiate a campaign of ethnic cleansing against the Tutsi minority, Paul is compelled to allow refugees to take shelter in his hotel. As the U.N. pulls out, Paul must struggle alone to protect the Tutsi refugees in the face of the escalating violence later known as the Rwandan genocide.

October 1st – October 31st Tuesdays & Thursdays 9:00 – 10:15am

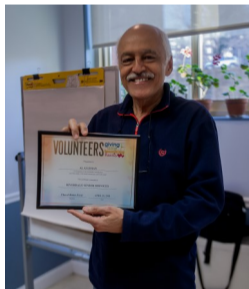
